MUSIC GENERATION MAYO

We are lucky to once again have the opportunity to participate in the Music Generation Mayo programme. The junior classes are once again taking part in the Ceol na nÓg Early Years Music Programme. The children will take part in weekly 45 minute lessons delivered during school time. This year the senior classes were also offered the chance to take part in the Céili Ukulele programme. The children in 3rd-6th class will learn contemporary songs and learn to accompany themselves on the ukulele taught by professional musicians visiting their classrooms. This year our lessons are again facilitated by local musician Gráinne Hambly.

These classes are match funded between the school and Music Generation.

However, our Parents Association, through their upcoming fundraising, and with the agreement of the Board of Management, have agreed to subsidise this programme so that there will be no cost to families.

CHILD PROTECTION AND ANTI-BULLYING INFORMATION
