# **NUT ALLERGY**

Two children in our school have a severe allergic reaction to all nuts. This allergic reaction (anaphylactic shock) can occur through ingestion of nut products and cross contamination. Since this condition can be life threatening, we are asking for your help in minimising the risk to this child by:

- a) Avoiding giving children any nuts in school lunches
- b) Avoiding giving nut butter sandwiches, other spreads containing nuts such as Nutella and snacks/bars containing nuts or labelled "may contain nut traces" in school lunches
- c) Asking children **not** to share their lunches.

Due to the severity of the problem, it is important that all parents carry out the suggested measures and reduce the risk of allergic reaction to this child.

# **NEW CLASSROOM:**

We received approval from the Dept. Education and Skills to build an additional classroom. The process is now underway. Our application for temporary accommodation was turned down. The Board of Management wishes to thank everyone, especially parents, who made representations on behalf of the school community to secure this funding.
